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1. Food Contact Compliance Declaration

Vetri Speciali S.p.A. **declares** that the containers produced in its plants and packaged in their original packaging are glass containers classified in Hydrolytic Class III, category "A" (soda-lime), i.e. suitable for any food-contact condition, including sterilization.

- The containers are manufactured in compliance with the following European legislation:
 - Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004 on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food.
 - Regulation (EC) No 2023/2006 on good manufacturing practice for materials and articles intended to come into contact with food.

and with the following Italian legislation:

- Decreto Ministeriale 21/03/1973 on the hygiene regulations for packaging, containers and utensils intended to come into contact with foodstuffs or with substances for personal use, as subsequently amended and supplemented.
- Decreto del Presidente della Repubblica n. 777 del 23/08/1982, implementing Directive 76/893/EEC on materials and articles intended to come into contact with food, as subsequently updated.
- The glass containers comply with the provisions of D.Lgs. n. 152/2006 (Testo Unico Ambientale - Italian Environmental Code).
- The glass containers comply with the requirements of Article 5 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40 (PPWR) insofar as applicable. With specific reference to the concentration levels of lead, cadmium, mercury and hexavalent chromium, reference is made to Decision 2001/171/EC, as amended by Decision 2006/340/EC, concerning the derogation applicable to glass packaging. Pursuant to Article 70 of Regulation (EU) 2025/40, that Decision remains in force and continues to apply until it is possibly repealed by delegated acts adopted by the Commission. The glass containers therefore comply with the limits applicable to glass packaging, equal to 200 ppm measured on an annual basis, under the conditions laid down by Decision 2001/171/EC and subsequent amendments.
- The manufacturing and handling processes of the containers are such that the presence of foreign bodies inside them can only result from accidental causes. In compliance with Regulation (EC) No 852/2004, in order to avoid contamination, all possible measures are taken to preserve the hygiene of the containers.
- The plastic materials intended to come into contact with the glass containers are regulated so as to ensure their safe use, in compliance with Regulation (EC) No 1935/2004, Regulation (EU) No 10/2011 and DM 21/03/1973.
- The glass containers are not sterilized and their use is permitted in accordance with the indications set out and described in the relevant technical data sheet.

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2. Declaration on glass composition and use of recycled glass

Vetri Speciali S.p.A. **declares** that the glass produced in its plants is of the soda-lime type, with the appreciable presence of the following oxides:

- Silica (SiO_2) 69 - 74%
- Sodium oxide (Na_2O) 11 - 15%
- Calcium oxide (CaO) 7 - 12%
- Potassium oxide (K_2O) 0 - 2%
- Aluminium oxide (Al_2O_3) 0.1 - 3%
- Minor components such as (Ba, Fe, Ti, Mg) < 8%

Other oxides may be present at trace levels.

- Recycled material (cullet) of both internal and external origin may be used in the glass production process, depending on the glass colour and on the availability and quantity of the raw material itself.
- The percentages of recycled material used may vary while complying with the heavy-metal content limits set by Commission Decision 2001/171/EC, as amended by Decision 2006/340/EC, equal to 200¹ ppm measured on an annual basis.

The typical percentages of internal and external recycled material vary according to the colour:

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4. Disposal declaration

Vetri Speciali S.p.A. **declares** that all packaging, both primary and secondary, making up the sales unit can be recycled and treated in accordance with the provisions of D.Lgs. n. 116/2020, implementing the Waste Directive (EU) 2018/851 and the Packaging Directive (EU) 2018/852.

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5. Declaration of absence of substances

Vetri Speciali S.p.A, **declares** that, given the characteristics of the product and of the production process, the following substances are not present and are not intentionally used or added in the glass containers:

- Bisphenol group;
- Allergens;
- Endocrine disruptors;
- MOSH (mineral oil saturated hydrocarbons), MOAH (mineral oil aromatic hydrocarbons);
- POSH (polyolefin oligomeric saturated hydrocarbons);
- Phthalates;
- PVC, PVDC and other chlorinated polymers;
- Dual-use additives;
- Genetically Modified Organisms (GMOs)
- PFAS (per- and polyfluoroalkyl substances).

The containers manufactured by the company contain, within the glass matrix, exclusively substances of mineral origin and, to the best of its knowledge, no substance of animal origin is used during the production cycle.

6. Irradiation and radiological risk

During the production stage, no radiation treatments (ionizing, radio-frequency, ultraviolet or pulsed) capable of altering their structure are applied to the containers we manufacture, and the raw materials used are, to the best of our knowledge, not irradiated.

No radioactive substances capable of altering the glass container and/or its contents are intentionally introduced or used in the production process.

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7. Chemical substances compliance declaration

7.1 REACH

Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006 (REACH), concerning the Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals, is the European Union regulatory framework on chemical substances and their safe use.

On 8 October 2008 the European Commission published Regulation (EC) No 987/2008, which clarifies that glass is a substance exempt from the registration obligation provided for by REACH.

On the basis of these provisions, Vetri Speciali S.p.A. **declares that**

- Its glass containers contain none of the Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC) included in Annex XIV to the REACH Regulation. This list, known as the SVHC "Candidate List", is periodically updated by ECHA and can be consulted online at: <http://echa.europa.eu/it/candidate-list-table>;
- The glass substance used to manufacture the containers does not appear in the list of Substances of Very High Concern (SVHC); therefore, there is no obligation to provide information to downstream users pursuant to Article 33 of Regulation (EC) No 1907/2006;
- The glass containers supplied are not subject to the provisions of the REACH Regulation since, as such, they cannot be classified as "articles that intentionally release substances";
- Soda-lime-silica glass is not classified as hazardous under Regulation (EC) No 1272/2008 and is not included in the list established pursuant to Article 59(1) of the REACH Regulation (SVHC); for this reason there is no obligation to provide a safety data sheet pursuant to Article 31 of the REACH Regulation;
- A mutual exchange of information is maintained with all suppliers in order to verify their position with regard to REACH and to any restrictions provided for under Annex XVII to the Regulation.

7.2 California Proposition 65

On the basis of the information currently available, no exposure risk to the chemical substances listed under the California Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1985 (Proposition 65) is known to arise from the use of the glass articles produced by the plant.

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
